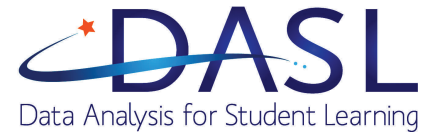
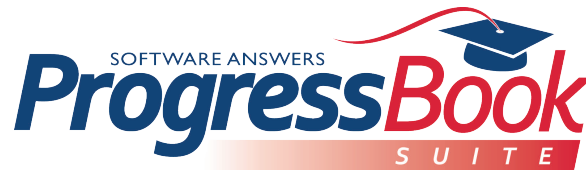
The ProgressBook Suite is being developed to meet the Instructional Improvement System (IIS) standards defined in Race to the Top.

ProgressBook began in 2002 as a single, web-based K-12 grade book application. Today, ProgressBook Suite includes six, feature-rich, comprehensive modules – and more by the end of 2012. Used by teachers, administrators, parents and students, the suite of ProgressBook modules includes:



- **GradeBook:** Student, classroom and district management supporting K-12 standards-based education practices with online attendance, lesson plans, grade book, report cards and more.
- **SpecialServices:** Special education (IEP and ETR) and gifted (WIP) programs management with forms, reporting and collaboration-building tools.



- **ParentAccess:** 24/7 Internet access by students and parents to student schedules, homework, grades, teacher messaging and school resources.
- **VirtualClassroom:** Now in development, will provide online educating for students in and outside of the classroom.
- **DataMap:** Data-driven online tool with aggregated and actionable information to help students improve their scores on state-standardized tests.
- **StudentInformation (DASL):** DASL is a feature-rich, state-of-the-art, web-based student information system first released in 2003. Now used by more than 75% of the state's school districts, this comprehensive

system is intuitive, easy to use, easy to navigate, and has a simple look and feel making it very user-friendly for both casual and intensive users.
